PROGRAM APPROACH

This package is a year-long commitment. During the Freshman year, the planning will include 3 strategic meetings that will allow students to begin strategizing earlier:

- Fall meeting: Discuss extra-curricular activities + evaluate academic planning + develop a test preparation plan
- Winter meeting: Discuss and plan summer program opportunities
- Early Spring meeting: Discuss and strategically plan for course selection for Sophomore Year + continue to follow up on summer program planning and executing summer program applications and essays
