TUITION & POLICIES

The best time to reserve a spot for this comprehensive package is Spring before Junior year. Space is limited.

The program typically begins Fall of Junior Year, and runs through the Senior Year application submission process. Should students enroll late, the consultant makes sure to catch up on meeting content. Meetings are typically 45-60 minutes. We typically do not meet students in April / May of Junior year due to heavy AP and Standardized Testing.

The Package rate starts at \$7,800 + potential supplemental essay fee, if applicable. Tuition due prior to start of services (cash or check only).

CONSULTANT'S ROLE

- Instill confidence, while providing support, guidance, and encouragement throughout the process.

- Evaluate student's academic history and records.
- Evaluate extra-curricular activities.
- Discuss coursework for Senior year.
- Provide career and assessment tools for discussions about potential majors.
- Provide personality assessment as an added value when discussing career plans.
- Develop a resume.
- Create a timetable for deadlines.
- Ensure all application questions are answered and prepared.
- Provide financial aid resources and tools.
- Provide interview preparation and tips, if applicable.
- Follow up with acceptance letter decisions.

ESSAY PREPARATION

Many of the hours in this package are spent developing the essays, which involves a creative brainstorming process, timelines, and multiple draft revisions with trained editors. This process includes:

- UC Personal Insights Questions
- Common Application Base Personal Statement
- Supplemental essays from 3 colleges
- Additional colleges requiring supplemental essays will incur a surcharge of \$350-\$450 per college.
- Students will be offered to attend our Summer College Essay Boot Camp if schedule permits.
