TUITION & POLICIES

The best time to reserve a spot for this comprehensive package is Spring before Sophomore year. Space is limited.

The Package rate starts at \$8,300 + potential supplemental essay fee, if applicable. Tuition due prior to start of services (cash or check only).

PROGRAM APPROACH

During the Sophomore year, the planning will include 3 strategic meetings that will allow students to begin strategizing earlier:

- Fall meeting: Discuss extra-curricular activities + evaluate academic planning + develop a test preparation plan
- Winter meeting: Discuss and plan summer program opportunities
- Early Spring meeting: Discuss and strategically plan for course selection for Junior Year + continue to follow up on summer program planning and executing summer program applications and essays
