TUITION & POLICIES

The best time to reserve a spot for this comprehensive package is Spring before Junior year. Space is limited.

The program typically begins Fall of Junior Year, and runs through December of Senior Year. Should students enroll late, the consultant makes sure to catch up on meeting content. Meetings are about 40-50 minutes. Planning meetings will begin September – January. In February – April – we do not meet as students are preparing for AP and Standardized Testing. When May arrives, we meet again and begin the actual application process.

The Package rate starts at \$8,500 + potential supplemental essay fee, if applicable. Tuition is due prior to start of services with a check payment.

NEXT STEPS

- Ensure all application questions are answered and prepared.
- Provide financial aid resources and tools.
- Provide interview preparation and tips, if applicable.
- Follow up with acceptance letter decisions.

PROGRAM APPLICATION AND ESSAY DETAILS

In addition to all the planning meetings – in Junior year – this program includes hours developing the essays, which involves a creative brainstorming process, timelines, and multiple draft revisions with trained editors. This process includes:

- Common Application Base Personal Statement + Application
- We cover 3 colleges on your list that ask for supplemental essays
- Additional colleges requiring supplemental essays will then incur a surcharge of \$350-\$450 per college.
