TUITION & POLICIES

The best time to reserve a spot for this comprehensive package is Spring before Sophomore year. Space is limited.

Should students enroll late, the consultant makes sure to catch up on meeting content. By having an extra year to begin college conversations, students will begin to map a plan of action. Meetings are typically 40-50 minutes.

The Package rate starts at \$9,000 + potential supplemental essay fee, if applicable. Tuition is due prior to start of services with a check payment.

CONSULTANT'S ROLE

- Instill confidence, while providing support, guidance, and encouragement throughout the process.
- Be a resource on topics including extra-curricular activities, academic planning, test preparation, summer program planning, applications, and essays.

PROGRAM APPROACH

During the Sophomore year, the planning will include 4 strategic meetings that will allow students to begin strategizing earlier:

- Fall meeting: Discuss extra-curricular activities + evaluate academic course planning
- Winter meeting part I: Discuss and plan summer program opportunities + develop a test preparation plan
- Winter meeting part II: Confirm summer programs and plans
- Early Spring meeting: Discuss and strategically plan for course selection for Junior Year + continue to follow up on summer program planning and executing summer program applications and essays
- After Sophomore year is over → the students will begin the Junior year planning in early Fall and the program continues.

PROGRAM APPLICATION AND ESSAY DETAILS

In addition to all the planning meetings – in Junior year – this program includes hours developing the essays, which involves a creative brainstorming process, timelines, and multiple draft revisions with trained editors. This process includes:

- UC Personal Insights Questions + Application
- Common Application Base Personal Statement + Application
- We cover 3 colleges on your list that ask for supplemental essays
- Additional colleges requiring supplemental essays will then incur a surcharge of \$350-\$450 per college.
